This is our new training program which partners with host ministries to train Christian leaders in other countries. These leaders are trained in basic Bible, doctrine, and skills that ground them in grace and in ministry. Nationals who are accepted into the GLI and complete the four-year training satisfactorily are awarded a certificate. Teachers are qualified and certified by GLI criteria.
