



A WORD FROM CHARLIE

The year 2020 will be a memorable one, not all for good reasons. We all suffered to one degree or another with lockdowns or seeing people we know get sick and/or die from the pandemic. We endured stressful racial tension, chaotic demonstrations, destruction of property, and random violence. Then there was the election!

Could the world look more dark and needy than it did in 2020? Well, yes, it could and it has seen darker times. Think about the pervasive moral darkness just before the birth of Jesus Christ. The center of civilization, Rome and its empire, was politically corrupt, oppressively cruel, sexually perverted, and religiously bankrupt. People found no hope of eternal life in idol and emperor worship, pagan rites, or Jewish legalism. The dark world needed a light.

Then light appeared! Jesus Christ, who called Himself "the light of the world" (John 8:12), dispelled the darkness with hope. The apostle John wrote, "In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. And the darkness did not comprehend it" (John 1:4-5). They ignore the hundreds of prophecies that predicted His coming and His eternal salvation. These facts make Jesus unique among anyone who ever lived. Those who ignore these facts remain in darkness and face an eternity separated from God's presence.

Is your life filled with joy or fear? With faith or doubt? With darkness or the Light of Life? You don't have to be without joy and a new life. God's Word says, "But as many as received Him (Jesus Christ), to them He (Jesus) gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His (Jesus') name" (John 1:12). To receive Jesus Christ is another way of saying believe in Him. To believe in His name means you accept as true and trust in who Jesus is (the Son of God) and what He has done (died in payment for your sins and rose from the dead to give eternal life).

Have you believed in the Lord Jesus Christ who loves you and paid the penalty for your sins? If not, I invite you to do so right now even as you read this. There are no magic rituals or prayers, no amount of good works or moral reform. Just believe in and receive His free gift. And if you do, why not tell God "Thank You" for this gift of His love and life?






· Help Needed ··

GraceLife's budget does not allow us to help all the needs that ministry partners share with us beyond the expenses of training pastors. Here is a list of some of their projects. If you can help, designate your gift accordingly and we will pass it on to them.

- Pakistan Raheel.S. is starting an online Urdu Bible school to train pastors. It is difficult to train in physical meetings.
 Estimated need for startup and translating books into Urdu: \$5000.
- Myanmar Joseph Sian has begun a building that will serve as his home, a church, children's home, and pastors' training center. Estimated need for the first building: \$18,000.
- Burundi Anicet Ndikuriyo's main Grace Bible Church is in danger of losing their lease on their main meeting place and office. They must purchase the property or will have to buy and develop their own. Estimated need: \$45,000.
